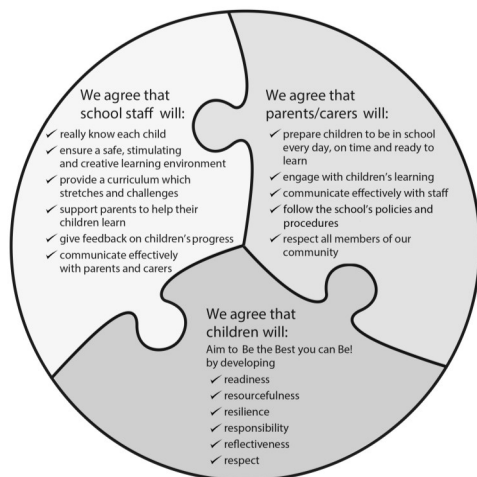


Our Learning Agreement

Attendance & Punctuality

Regular school attendance is important to ensure children get maximum benefit from the opportunities for learning which are available to them. The responsibility for ensuring children attend school regularly and punctually rests with parents and carers.

Every child is expected to have an attendance of 96.5% and you will be contacted if it drops below this. Being late by just 10 minutes every day is the equivalent of missing 7 days of school in a year.

Our School Uniform

We take pride in creating an environment where every opportunity is offered to inspire children to learn. We believe that, by having a uniform, children arrive ready for their learning as equals. Once in school, each child's individuality is nurtured.

Ensuring that our uniform is worn consistently is the shared responsibility of children, parents and staff.

Home Learning

We provide home learning to develop children's independence and confidence, consolidating what is being taught in school and preparing them for future learning. We recognise that children and their families have differing circumstances and we aim to make our home learning appropriate and accessible for all pupils.

Reading - Children are expected to read for at least 20 minutes every day. This helps improve their comprehension and their writing, as well as build their stamina. They will also have questions and tasks to finish in their reading journal.

Maths - At least 5 Mathletics tasks are set each week. (Children can do these at school if needed.)

Times tables - every Monday

Spelling test - every Friday
