#### **Year 6 SATs Success**

We are delighted that our broad and rich Community Curriculum along with our incredibly high academic expectations have again produced fantastic Key Stage 2 results! 90% of Year 6 pupils achieved expected standards in reading compared to 75% nationally. 90% achieved expected standards in maths compared to 76% nationally. Whilst 84% achieved expected standards in writing compared to 78% nationally. Overall 82% achieved expected standards for reading, writing and maths (combined) compared to 64% nationally.

At Heathbrook we believe that progress is even more important than attainment; we know our pupils have made amazing progress too, however progress data has not been published yet. The whole school teaching team are really proud of the hard work and commitment the children have shown towards learning.
