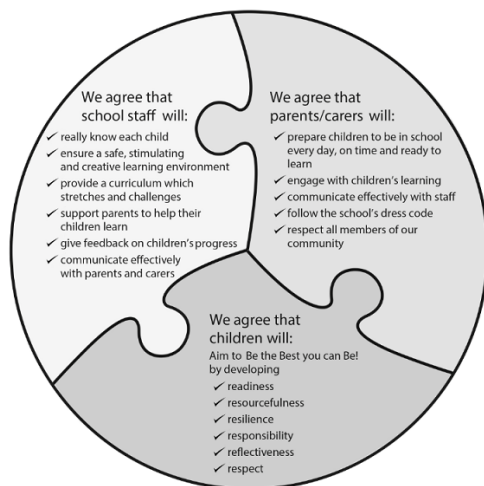


## Our Learning Agreement

## Attendance & Punctuality

Regular school attendance is important to ensure children get maximum benefit from the opportunities for learning which are available to them. The responsibility for ensuring children attend school regularly and punctually rests with parents and carers.

Every child is expected to have an attendance of 96.5% and you will be contacted if it drops below this. Being late by just 10 minutes every day is the equivalent of missing 7 days of school in a year.

## Our School Uniform

We take pride in creating an environment where every opportunity is offered to inspire children to learn. We believe that, by having a uniform, children arrive ready for their learning as equals. Once in school, each child's individuality is nurtured.

## Home Learning

We provide home learning to develop children's independence and confidence, consolidating what is being taught in school and preparing them for future learning.

- **Reading** - Children should read every day for a minimum of 20 minutes.
- **Spelling, punctuation and grammar** - They will still be set SPAG homework each week, that will be given out and handed in during guided reading lessons on Mondays.
- **Spellings** - They will be set and tested on Fridays
- **Mathletics** - Children have activities to complete on Mathletics (at least 10 activities per week) . This needs to be a priority for all children.
